Part 1: Embracing God's Grand Adventure!

Three truths about God's Grand Adventure:

1.	There is one ultimate

Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, you will be for me a **kingdom** of priests and a holy nation. These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites. Exodus 19:5-6

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a **boly nation**, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 1 Peter 2:9

But he said, "I must preach the good news of the **kingdom** of God to the other towns also, because that is why I was sent." Luke 4:43

But seek first his **kingdom** and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Matthew 6:33

He told them still another parable: "The **kingdom** of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into a large amount of flour until it worked all through the dough." Matthew 13:33

Again he said, "What shall we say the **kingdom** of God is like, or what parable shall we use to describe it? It is like a mustard seed, which is the smallest seed you plant in the ground. Yet when planted, it grows and becomes the largest of all garden plants, with such big branches that the birds of the air can perch in its shade." Mark 4:30-32

Daily Meditations

Spend some time each day this week meditating on today's topic.

This week's memory verse:

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 1 Peter 2:9

Monday

Look back over the notes and read the verses they contain. Think about following God - how do that work out in your life? Do you see following God as an adventure, is it frightening, is it drudgery, is it a battle of wills, a mixture of things? Why is that?

What do you think of when you hear the word "missions"? How have you been involved in missions in the past? How will you be involved in missions this year?

Thank God today for the privilege of following Him. Thank Him for the comfort of following a perfectly loving, just and all-knowing God. Ask God to soften your heart to His voice and leading. Pray that your heart will align more and more with His. Pray that He'll show you ways to be involved in reaching out.

Tuesday

Read Genesis 1:1, 1 Chronicles 29:11, Psalm 103:19 & John 14:6. How do these verses point to the fact that there is an ultimate King? How is He described in these verses?

When did you first believe in the Kingship of Christ in your life?

Write down three ways that decision to believe has been an adventure for you.

Wednesday

Read Exodus 19:5-6, Matthew 6:9-10, 33; 13:31-33, 44-45. According to these verses, what is God's kingdom like?

Why do you think the prayer found in Matthew 6:9-10 is important? Why is it important right now in your life to pray that prayer?

The kingdom of God seems like such an ethereal concept sometimes. What have you learned about God's kingdom to help you understand what a real thing it is?

Thank God today for His kingdom. Thank Him for including you in His kingdom. Ask Him to create a willingness in you to say "Thy will be done" through each part of the day. Pray that as you deal with the details of life you won't forget the eternal kingdom you belong to.

Thursday

Read John 8:31, 15:15; 2 Corinthians 5:20a & 1 Peter 2:9. What are those who belong to God's kingdom called, according to these verses?

It is an amazing thing to realize that the King of all loves you and wants you to be part of His Kingdom and its purpose! Let that truth swirl in your head for a few minutes. Write down two ways this truth can impact your daily life.
