Requesting Guidance

1. Believe God

2. Ask God

3. Expect God

"... God is always ready to give bountiful supply of wisdom to all who ask Him; He will not resent it. But when you ask Him, be sure that you really expect Him to tell you..." James 1:5b-6 (TLB)

: Let God speak to you "I will look to see what He will say to me." Hab 2:1 (NIV)
