Why pray for others?

"After Jesus had gone indoors, his disciples asked him privately, 'Why couldn't we drive it out?' He replied, 'This kind can come out **only by prayer**.'" Mark 9:28,29

My prayers...

1. ...Can help

"So Peter was kept in prison, but **the church was earnestly praying to God for bim**. ...Suddenly an angel of the Lord appeared and a light shone in the cell. He struck Peter on the side and woke him up. 'Quick, get up!' he said, and the chains fell off Peter's wrists." Acts 12:5-7

2. ...Can help

"I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone-- **for kings and all those in authority**, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness." 1Tim. 2:1,2

"I tell you: Love your enemies and **pray** for those who persecute you" Matt. 5:44

3. ...Can help

Jesus: "Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift you as wheat. But **I have prayed for you**, Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers." Luke 22:31-32

4. ...Can help

"**Pray** that I may be rescued from the unbelievers in Judea and that my service in Jerusalem may be acceptable to the saints there..." Rom. 15:31

5. ...Can help

Studies Showing a Positive Effect of Prayer on Health

Krucoff, M. W., et al. 2001. *Integrative noetic therapies as adjuncts to percutaneous intervention during unstable coronary syndromes*. Am. Heart J. 142: 760-767. A pilot study (limited to 150 patients) examining the efficacy of noetic (non-pharmacological) therapies (stress relaxation, imagery, touch therapy, and prayer) found that "Of all noetic therapies, off-site intercessory prayer had the lowest short- and long-term absolute complication rates." A full study is planned.

Bliss, J.R., McSherry, E., and Fassett, J. 1995. *Chaplain Intervention Reduces Costs in Major DRGs*. NIH Conference on Spirituality and Health Care Outcomes. Patients in the intervention group had an average 2 day shorter post-op hospitalization, resulting in an overall cost savings of \$4,200 per patient. Randomized 331 open-heart surgery patients to either a chaplain intervention or usual care.
