Daily Meditations

Memory Verse: "You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:32

Monday

Read John 8:31-59. Look back over your notes from last weekend. What most often hinders you from experiencing freedom in Christ?

What truth did you learn that can help you live in freedom this week? How will you apply that to your life?

Thank God today for the freedom He longs to give you. Pray about the things that hinder you from living in that freedom. Ask God to teach you this week about it what means to be truly free.

Tuesday

Read John 8:33-34, Galatians 5:1 & 2 Peter 2:18-19. How is sin a form of slavery? How have you seen the truth of that in your life?

Think about your life right now. In what way(s) are you feeling enslaved by sin? How has that impacted your daily life?

Write down two truths you know from the Bible that could help you experience freedom over that sin.

Thank God today that you have a choice—you don't have to be enslaved to sin. Thank God for caring about your struggles. Talk to Him about the sin you feel is enslaving you right now. Pray that the two truths you wrote down will begin to take hold in your life. Pray that you will experience freedom in new ways today.

Wednesday

Read John 8:39-44 & Galatians 5:22-26. What truth was Jesus trying to teach the Jews in this passage? How does this apply to your life?

Think about yesterday. What would you say the fruit of your day was?

Spend some time thinking about the legacy (fruit) you want to leave. Write down three choices you can make each day that will demonstrate your freedom in Christ.

Thursday

Read John 6:36-38 & John 8:53-59. What response did people have to Jesus in this passage?

Write down some of the responses you've had to Jesus in your life.

When you're confronted with the truth of Christ are you more prone to trying divert attention to others, argue with Jesus or surrender to Him? Why is that?

How can you seek God's glory over your own in your work and home today?

Thank God today that you are free to respond to Him. Pray that as you are given the opportunity to obey God today that you'll respond by surrendering to Him.

Friday

Read Psalm 18:30, John 8:36; Romans 8:15 & Galatians 4:7. What do these verses say about being a child of God, not a slave?

How does it comfort you to know that God wants you to be His child, not His slave?

Read Psalm 18:30, Isaiah 40:8, John 5:24 & John 8:37. What do learn about God's Word in these verses?

What difference does it make when you make God's Word a priority in your life?

Thank God today for His love and His word. Pray that you will keep God's Word as the priority in your life. Pray too that you will remember that you are God's child.
