JOSHUA 6

Now these things occurred as examples to us... 1 Corinthians 10:6

Now the gates of **Jericho** were securely barred because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in. Joshua 6:1

JERICO: Correlation between archaeological evidence and Biblical narrative

- Jericho heavily fortified, walled city (Joshua 2:5,7,15)
- Some dwellings “part of” wall (Joshua 2:15)
- Short siege just after spring harvest (Joshua 3:15, 5:10)
- Walls fell outward, forming ramp into city (Joshua 6:5,20)
- One part of wall spared from collapse (Joshua 6:22)
- City not plundered (Joshua 6:17-18)
- City burned (Joshua 6:24)

2. TRUST THAT GOD'S _____ (EVEN WHEN IT SEEMS _____)

“March around the city... Do this for six days. Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams’ horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have the whole army give a loud shout; **then the wall of the city will collapse** and the army will go up, everyone straight in.” Joshua 6:3-5

So Joshua son of Nun called the priests and said to them, “Take up the ark of the covenant of the LORD and have seven priests carry trumpets in front of it.” And he ordered the army, “Advance! March around the city, with an armed guard going ahead of the ark of the LORD.” Joshua 6:6,7
