### Monday

Look back over the message notes from this past weekend. Which points really stood out for you?

Thank God today for His Word, the Bible. Thank Him for the opportunity to learn and study. Ask Him to help you apply what you learn.

### Tuesday

Read Romans 8:31. Is it hard for you to believe that God is truly on your side?

Why or why not?

Read Jeremiah 29:11, Deuteronomy 31:8, Joshua 1:9. What do these verses all have in common?

Thank God today that He is on your side. Thank Him for the confidence this brings. Ask Him to strengthen your faith today and rejoice in being His child.

#### Wednesday

Read Romans 8:32. What will God give us, according to this verse?

Here's a brief list of some of God's gifts for you from Romans chapter 8:

You've been released from condemnation, holy and blameless in God's eyes (8:1) Your sins-- past, present, and future-- are all paid for by Jesus (8:3) You have the Holy Spirit in you (8:9) You have God's power in you (8:11) You're adopted by God (8:15) You are heirs of all God's riches (8:18) You are prayed for and cared for by the Spirit of God (8:26, 27) You have a guarantee that all things will work out for good (8:28) You've been destined for Christ-like character (8:29, 30) You've been chosen by God (8:33) You have God on your side! (8:31)

Thank God today for the many blessings you have in Christ. Thank Him for His mercy and grace. Ask Him to remind you throughout the day that He is for you and He is with you each step of the way!

### Thursday

Which of these terms do you tend to associate with God: against you; condemning you; accusing you; choosing you; for you.

Read Romans 8:33-34. What terms are associated with God in these verses? What terms are associated with the enemies of God?

Thank God today that because of Jesus' death on the cross you are declared "not guilty". Thank Him that you have become a friend of God through Jesus. Ask Him to help you live confidently today, as a loved child.

# Friday

Today, read ahead to next week's passage: Romans 8:35-39. What seems to be the point of this passage?

What is your emotional and intellectual response to this passage?

How should the truths in this passage change the way you live your life?

Thank God today that nothing can separate you from His love. Commit to Him the areas that are causing you to feel insecure right now. Ask Him to help you remember that nothing in all creation will stop God's love for you. Pray that you will be an encouragement to the people you encounter today.

### Saturday

Finish up any devotions you may have missed this week, and memorize that verse on the top of the previous page! *Thank God for his wonderful blessings He gives us through Jesus! Please pray for the services this weekend-- that they would glorify God!*
