Monday

Read Isaiah 6:1-8. Look back over your notes from this past weekend. What made the biggest impression on you?

What two things come to mind when you think about world missions?

How have you been involved with missions (locally and globally) in the past?

What impact has it made on your life?

Thank God today for His love for the world. Thank Him for including you in His plan to reach the world. Ask Him to give you creativity and boldness in reaching out to share the Gospel.

Tuesday

Read Isaiah 6:1. The king's death brought uncertainty into Isaiah's life. What uncertainties are you facing in life right now?

What changed Isaiah's perspective?

How can knowing "the Lord is on His throne, high and exalted" change your perspective in the face of uncertainties?

Thank God today for His control and power. Thank Him for the opportunity to tell others about Him. Pray that you would grow in both wisdom and grace today. Ask for opportunities to share your faith with others today.

Wednesday

Read Isaiah 6:1-3. What is the scene in Heaven according to these verses?

What are the angels singing around the throne of God?

Why do you think this “peek” into Heaven is recorded in the Bible?

How does your view of God impact your desire to reach out to others?

Thank God today for His majesty and holiness. Thank Him for the hope of eternity in heaven. Ask Him to give you boldness in telling people about the good news of His amazing grace.

Thursday

Read Isaiah 6:4-6. What was Isaiah’s response to seeing God’s awesome holiness and majesty?

Describe a time when you witnessed God’s majesty and power.

How did that impact your view of God? How did it impact your view of yourself?

Read Lamentations 3:19-25. How can you relate to these verses?

What do these verses tell you about God’s view of you?

How can you reflect the mercy God has shown you to reach out to those around you today?

Thank God today for His power. Thank Him that He knows the whole truth about you and thank Him for His mercy and kindness. Thank Him for the forgiveness of sin you have through Jesus Christ.

Friday

Read Isaiah 6:8 & Acts 1:8. Spend time meditating on these verses today. Pray through them and think about these questions:

Have I honestly given my life to God? Can I say, “Here am I. Send me!”?

Who are the people in my “Jerusalem” - those in my daily world?

How will I be intentional about reaching out?

Where do I believe God wants to send me? What’s holding me back?
