Meditations for the New Year Daily meditations based on this week's message

This week's memory verse:

Monday

Read Luke 6:46-49. What stood out to you most from the sermon this last weekend? Why?

What is your main struggle when it comes to surrendering your life to Jesus to be Lord?

Spend time in prayer today and ask God to open your heart this week to areas of your life that you are not allowing Him to be Lord over. Thank God today for His mercy and love for you. Thank Him for His patience with you as you learn and grow. Ask Him to soften your heart to His voice this week. Ask for a sincere desire to surrender to Him as Lord.

Tuesday

Read Luke Genesis 12:1-4 & Luke 6:46 . What are two things that strike you in these verses?

Wednesday

Read Luke 6:47-48. These verses are full of descriptive words. Write down three that stand out to you and why.

According to verse 47, how does the wise builder respond to the Word of God?

Verse 48 says the wise builder "dug down deep" and laid the foundation on rock". How are you doing that in your life right now? Why are you hesitant to do that?

How does obedience to God bring security to your life?

Thank God today that He clearly lays out the way to have a strong foundation. Ask Him to help you dig down deep and build on the rock. Ask Him for an opportunity to encourage someone in your life today with the truth of what you're studying.

Thursday

Read Matthew 7:26-27 & Luke 6:49. What are some "sandy" foundations that you've tried to build your life on? What were the results?

What is the foolish builder's reaction to the Word of God?

Both the wise and foolish builder experienced life's storms. How do you think obeying God impacts how you handle life's storms?

Spend an extended time in prayer today. Ask God to show you any areas where you are building on sand. As those come to mind write them down and then commit to "rebuild" those foundations on the Rock, Jesus.

Friday

Read Luke 6:46-49 & James 1:22-25. How do these passages relate to each other?

What insights does the James passage add to the importance of obeying God's Word?

Think back over what you've learned from studying God's Word in the last week. How can you "put feet" to what you've learned and ensure that you are not just one who hears the Word, but does the Word as well?

Thank God today that He cares about you and wants to help you weather life's storms. Ask Him to give you the desire and courage to apply what you learn from Him and His Word. Ask Him to help you choose to be a wise builder each and every day.
