Daily Meditations

Monday

Tuesday

Read 1 John 3:11-15. What message has been taught "from the beginning"? How can such a simple message make such a difference?

Read Genesis 4:1-8. Why do you think John included the used the story of Cain and Abel as an illustration? Examine your heart today. Do you hate anyone? What is the impact of hate on your life?

Have you ever felt the truth of verse 13 in you life? Why do you think that living a life of love is a good reaction to the world's hate?

Thank God today for His example of love. Talk to Him about any struggles you are having with hate. Ask Him to empower you to live a life of love in the face of hate. Pray that God will shine through you today in all your interactions.

Wednesday

Read 1 John 3:16. This verse is short but powerful. According to this verse who is our example when it comes to love and what example did He leave for us?

How does this type of love differ from romantic love? How does this type of love differ from what the world offers?

This type of love is difficult to have towards those you love much less those who you find difficult to love! Write down two ways you can demonstrate this type of love towards those around you this week:

Thank God today for His example of love. Pray that your life will be full of the "fruits" mentioned in Galatians 5:22. Ask God to soften your heart and increase your desire to love those around you.
