#### Questions to help you stay discerning

- 1. How does this relate to the core teachings of the Bible? "In the essentials, unity. In the non-essentials, diversity. In all things, charity (love)." –Augustine
- 2. What would my spiritual role models advise? (Have they addressed it?)
- 3. Does this distract me (or others) from a pure and simple devotion to Christ?

## **Daily Meditations**

### This week's memory verse:

### Monday

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Look back over your notes and read Revelation 2:18-28. What are the strengths of this church?

What is its main weakness?

How is the problem in Thyatira like (and unlike) that in Pergamum (the previous church)?

How do you relate to the strengths and weaknesses of this church?

Who or what has played a role similar to this "Jezebel" in your life? (You don't need to name names publicly!) How did you escape their influence on you?

Ask Jesus to help you see what He wants you to hear in His message to this church.

**Tuesday** 

The theme of the letter to Thyatira is *guard against false teachers*. Do you ever feel a tension between being too tolerant and too judgmental? On what issues do you feel the most tension?

Read this week's memory verse. Where do you think Christians today are being led into false teaching that distracts from a pure and simple devotion to Christ?

Paul addresses the danger of false teachers in 1 Timothy 1:3-7. What are some of the characteristics of false teaching, according to these verses?

How is a true teacher's goal (verse 5) different from the result of false teaching (verses 4, 6)?

Ask God to help you distinguish between the essentials and the nonessentials of the faith. Thank Him for His word and His Spirit which guides us into all truth!

Wednesday

Peter is very blunt about the dangers of false teachers in 2 Peter 2:1-22. What are some of the characteristics of false teachers? (See verses 3, 10, 14, 15, 18, 19)

Why do you think Peter, who knew Jesus personally, is so upset about teachers who distort the teachings of Jesus?

Do you think Christians tend to be gullible when it comes to teachers within the church? Why or why not? Why are false teachers tolerated in churches today?

Ask God to help you discern between false teachers and true.

**Thursday** 

Read Matt 7:15-23. What does Jesus Himself tell us to watch out for? How are we to recognize false teachers, according to verse 16?

What is the difference between a teacher's gifts and a teacher's fruit?

If prophesying, driving out demons, and performing miracles is not what Jesus means by "doing the will of my Father". then what is?

Ask God to help you discern the truth! Thank Him for His concern for you.

**Friday** 

Get ready for this weekend's message by reading Rev. 3:1-6. What's the problem with this church?

What questions would you like to have answered about this text?

How does your reputation compare with your reality?

Ask God to help you strengthen the areas in your spiritual life that are weak.
