GOD'S TAKE ON A SURRENDERED LIFE

Jesus through the eyes of the world:
"Once when Jesus was praying in private and his disciples were with him, he aske them, 'Who do the crowds say I am?' They replied, 'Some say John the Baptist; other say Elijah; and still others, that one of the prophets of long ago has come back to life.'" Luke 9:18-19
2. Jesus through the eyes of His followers:
"'But what about you?' he asked. 'Who do you say I am?' Peter answered, 'The Chri of God.'" Luke 9: 20
3. Jesus' self-revelation:
"Jesus strictly warned them not to tell this to anyone. And he said, 'The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life.'" Luke 9:21-2
4. God's expectation of His people:
"Then he said to them all: 'If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself

and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it. What good is it for a man to

gain the whole world, and yet lose or forfeit his very self?" Luke 9:23-25

Tuesday

How would you answer Him and how have you come to that answer in your life?

Why is it important for Jesus' followers to know that He is the Son of God?

How can that knowledge impact your daily life?

Thank God today for sending His Son Jesus to the earth. Thank God for the truth found in the Bible. Pray that you will live in an awareness of the fact that you are loved by God.

Wednesday

Read Matt. 20:25-28, Mark 14:32-36, Luke 9:21-22 & Phil. 2:5-11. How do these verses show Jesus' example of surrender to God's will?

What encouragement do you receive from knowing that Jesus also had to submit His will and desires?

In what are are you currently struggling with surrendering your will to God's? How can you apply the verses you read today and Jesus' example to help you in that area?

Thank God today for His love for you. Thank Him that you can trust Him with your life. Talk to Him about the areas you are finding it difficult to surrender to Him. Ask Him to help you release your grip and give those to Him.

Thursday

Read Matt. 16:24-26, Mark 12:29-31, Luke 9:23-25 & John 12:23-26. Write down three things that stand out to you in these verses:

Thank God today that He has included you in His plan for the world! Ask Him to keep His commission at the front of your mind and give you the courage to be purposeful about fulfilling it.
