Read Ephesians 6:16-18. Which of these pieces of armor do you need the most today?

This weekend we will talk more about prayer as a part of the spiritual battle. Spend some extra time in prayer today listening for God's voice. Pray that Spiritual Armor prayer today, but in your own words.

The Apostle Paul teaches in Ephesians 6 that we are in a spiritual battle.

Three errors I must avoid about the battle:

1. Don't be ______ : I have an ______ !

"Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes." *Ephesians* 6:11

"Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour." 1 Peter 5:8

2. Don't be : My battle's not against !

"For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the **powers** of this dark world and against the **spiritual forces of evil** in the heavenly realms." Ephesians 6:12

3. Don't be _____: Take steps to _____

"Therefore **put on the full armor of God**, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand." Ephesians 6:13

Six essential parts of the armor of God:

"Stand firm then, with the **belt of truth** buckled around your waist, with the **breastplate of** righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God." Ephesians 6:14-17

By faith, I take up the sword of the Spirit. Help me to see the incomparably great power of the Holy Spirit available to me. Thank you for the Word inspired by that same Holy Spirit. Help me today, Lord, by your power.

May this day be a day of victory! In Jesus' name, amen."

Wednesday

Read Ephesians 6:14 and John 8:43-45. In John 8, Jesus is speaking to religious leaders. It's possible to be very religious and yet still be vulnerable to the lies of the devil.

What lies are you hearing?

Lies about my value: "You are worthless. God doesn't really love you!"

Lies about God's concern: "If God exists, He doesn't care about your problem!"

- Lies about what God approves: "Go ahead God just wants you to be happy!"
- Lies about what's true: "The only thing that matters is if you're sincere!"
- Lies about my potential: "You could never be used by God!"
- Lies about consequences of my behavior: "No one will ever know."
- Lies about what matters: "This world is all there is!"

Lies about my future: "Your life's been a waste, and nothing good is ahead!" over IST
