I. The Tactics of Dream Busters

Tactic #1:			
"But when Sanballat the Horonite, Tobiah the Ammonite official and Geshem the Arab heard about it, they mocked and ridiculed us. 'What is this you are doing?' they asked. 'Are you rebelling against the king?'" <i>Nehemiah 2:19</i> "When Sanballat heard that we were rebuilding the will he became angry and was greatly incensed and he ridiculed the Jews in the presence of the associates and the army of Samaria and he said `What are those feeble Jews doing? Will they restore their wall? Will they offer sacrifices? Will the finish in a day ? Can they bring stones back to life from those heaps of rubble burned as they are: Tobiah the Ammonite who was by his side said, `What are they building? Even if a fox climbed upon it, he would break down their wall of stones. " <i>Nehemiah 4:1-3</i>			
"But when Sanballat, Tobiah, the Arabs, the Ammonites and the men of Ashdod heard that the repairs to Jerusalem's walls had gone ahead and that the gaps were being closed, they were very angry. They all plotted together to come and fight against Jerusalem and stir up trouble against it." <i>Nehemiah</i> 4:7-8

Daily Meditations

Take a few minutes each day to read Bible passages and answer questions based on this week's message.

Monday

Who in your life can you encourage this week? Think of someone who may be discouraged. Call them or write a note... today!

Thank God that He gives an antidote to discouragement. Ask Him to help you apply what you've learned and to be an encourager to others.

Wednesday

Reread Nehemiah 4:14-18. How does remembering who God is change the attitude of the Israelites?

Read Deuteronomy 7:9, 20:4; Psalms 54:4, 116:5; Isaiah 12:2; and Zephaniah 3:17. What do each of these verses teach you about God?

How can remembering these truths help you move past discouragement?

Thank God today for His Word and its reminder to you of who God is. Ask Him to help you remember these truths, and apply them to combat discouragement.

Thursday

Read Micah 6:8 and Matt. 22:36-40. Nehemiah reminded the people of their purpose:

To build the wall! Often discouragement and dreambusters distract us from our life purpose. According to these verses, what are you and I here to do?

How can dreambusters distract us from these goals?

"Don't be afraid of them. Remember the Lord, who is great and awesome, and fight for your brothers, your sons and your daughters, your wives and your homes."
