BIG IDEA: These are all traits of insecure people. The cure: Resting securely in God's love for me.

God already loves me...

• Lavishly

"How **great is the love** the Father has **lavished** on us, that we should be called children of God!" 1 John 3:1a (NIV)

• Unconditionally

"But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: **While we were still sinners**, Christ died for us." *Romans 5:8* (NIV)

• Unfailingly

"I'm absolutely convinced that nothing — nothing living or dead, angelic or demonic, today or tomorrow, high or low, thinkable or unthinkable — **absolutely nothing can get between us and God's love** because of the way that Jesus our Master has **embraced** us." *Romans* 8:38,39 (Message)
