## Why should I forgive?

# Because a lack of forgiveness

#### Because Christ

"Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you." Colossians 3:13 (NIV)

#### Because Christ commands me

"And when you stand praying, **if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him**, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins." Mark 11:25

## Practical ways to "keep no record of wrongs":

#### 1. Deal with it

"And 'don't sin by letting anger control you.' Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry." Ephesians 4:26 (NLT)

**2. Determine to** "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:32 (NIV)
