4 Ways to Tell God I Love Him

1.	to Him
	"But I trust in your unfailing love ; my heart rejoices in your salvation. I will sing to the LORD , for he has been good to me." <i>Psalm 13:5-6</i>
	"Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord." <i>Ephesians 5:19</i>
2.	to Him
	"Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever." Psalm 107:1 (Commanded 7 times!)
	QUESTION: Have I thanked God for His love for me today?
	QUESTION: Have I told God I love Him today?
3.	to Him
	"Within your temple, O God, we meditate on your unfailing love." Psalm 48:9
	"Whoever is wise, let him heed these things and consider the great love of the LORD ." <i>Psalm 107:43</i> (See Philippians 4:8)
	QUESTION: Have I listened to God tell me He loves me today?
4.	to Him
	"I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me ." <i>Matthew 25:40</i> (See 1 John 3:17)
	"This is love for God: to obey his commands." 1 John 5:3a (2,000 times in Scripture God says to help the poor!)
	QUESTION: Do I give to the "least of these" as if I were giving to Jesus?
