How have you reached out to people in those conditions?

Why is it important to Jesus that we combine this kind of action with our verbal witness and not just have a verbal witness alone?

Thank God today for those who have come along side you to help you in the past. Pray that your eyes will be open and your heart will be willing to reach out to those in need who you will encounter today. Pray that your actions will point people to Jesus.

# **Saturday**

Please read Luke 10:2-3. As you pray today talk to God about being one of His "workers", ready to do whatever it takes to prepare for and work the harvest.

How does it help you to know that God promises to be with you as you go to the harvest?

#### • We are all missionaries!

Begin to view ourselves, not as consumers, but as givers/goers.

Incarnational Ministry includes:

# **Hyperbolic Growth**

- Each Christian commits to bring 2 people to faith in Jesus in their lifetime.
- Each church commits to start 2 churches that are empowered to start 2 as well.

Consider the story of the inventor of the chess game. As a reward for his invention he was offered one free wish as his reward by the king of India. He asked for one kernel on the first square of the chess board to be doubled for every section of the chess board — 64 sections in all. The king initially smiled but the end result was that he would have to give him 2 to the 63rd (9,223,372,036,854,775,808) kernels of rice... or over 284 billion tons of rice — more rice than the world can harvest in 500 years!

Ask God to open your eyes to opportunities to be a "missionary" locally and globally.
