January 9 & 10: Rekindle My Relationships


Are the holidays a relationship minefield for you? Learn how can you ease family tensions and bring laughter and love back to your relationships!

WHY CELEBRATE CHRISTMAS?



Our entire concert — the songs we sing, the imagery you see, the message you hear — is a celebration of the most amazing event in history:

A baby boy was born.

But this wasn't any ordinary birth. Foretold centuries before, a son was miraculously born to a virgin. The heavens resounded with the song of angels. A star shone above his birthplace, leading men to worship him. This was truly a birthday like none other.

But the story started before this.

People were created by God to live in perfect union with him.
