Pride, the opposite of humility, can sneak into life in many ways and it often serves to mask a feeling of being unqualified. In what area of your life are you struggling with pride?

It seems odd that a humble attitude can help you when you're struggling with feeling unqualified. According to the verses you read today, how is that possible?

Thank God today that He sees things from an eternal perspective. Confess to Him the areas you struggle with pride. Ask Him to help you develop a humble attitude in your daily life.

Friday

Please read 1 Samuel 17:17–18, 20 and Psalm 119:58–60. It sometimes seems easier to obey God in the big issues than the small ones. How does obedience in the small things make a difference?

What are the benefits of obeying God in big and small things?

How could obedience in the small things help you when you feel unqualified?

Thank God today for His love for you and His desire to help you. Pray that you will have the desire to obey and that you will rely on God's strength to make the right choices.

Please read Psalm 62. Write down three things that encourage you in this passage. Please pray for the services this weekend. Please pray that God will use the car show to reach people who do not normally come to church!
