## THE LIGHT OF CHRISTMAS



Our concert is a celebration of the most amazing event in history:

## A baby boy was born.

But this was no ordinary child. This baby brought light into our dark world.

The Scriptures tell us lights were everywhere at his birth: In the glory of the angels shining on the shepherds, in the light of a star leading the Magi to Bethlehem, and even in the prophecies of a light that would come from heaven to shine on us.

# "On those living in the land of deep darkness a light has dawned." Isaiah 9:2


God did this for one reason: He loves you.
