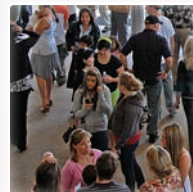

THE LIGHT OF CHRISTMAS



Our concert is a celebration of the most amazing event in history:

A baby boy was born.

But this was no ordinary child. This baby brought light into our dark world.

The Scriptures tell us lights were everywhere at his birth: In the glory of the angels shining on the shepherds, in the light of a star leading the Magi to Bethlehem, and even in the prophecies of a light that would come from heaven to shine on us.

“On those living in the land of deep darkness a light has dawned.” Isaiah 9:2

The story of Christmas light begins long ago, even before the birth of Jesus. At the very beginning of time, God said, “Let there be light!” and created a perfect world where people could live in harmony with Him and walk in His light.

But humans brought darkness into that world when they rebelled against God. The consequences were far-reaching: Pain, suffering, and an acute sense of loneliness for a relationship with God. We longed for His light to come to our darkness.
