REDISCOVERING THE WORD OCTOBER 11 & 12 // MARK SPURLOCK

In the eighteenth year of his reign, King Josiah sent the secretary, Shaphan... to the temple of the LORD. He said: "Go up to Hilkiah the high priest and have him get ready the money that has been brought into the temple of the LORD, which the doorkeepers have collected from the people. Have them entrust it to the men appointed to supervise the work on the temple. And have these men pay the workers who repair the temple of the LORD—the carpenters, the builders and the masons. Also have them purchase timber and dressed stone to repair the temple. 2 Kings 22:3–6

Hilkiah the high priest said to Shaphan... "I have found the Book of the Law in the temple of the LORD." 2 Kings 22:8a

He gave it to Shaphan, who read it. Then Shaphan... went to the king and reported to him: "Your officials have paid out the money... and have entrusted it to the workers and supervisors at the temple." Then Shaphan... informed the king, "Hilkiah the priest has given me a book." And Shaphan read from it in the presence of the king. 2 Kings 22:8b–10

When the king heard the words of the Book of the Law, he tore his robes. 2 Kings 22:11

He gave these orders to Hilkiah... Ahikama... Akbor... Shaphan... and Asaiah the king's attendant: "Go and inquire of the LORD for me and for the people and for all Judah about what is written in this book that has been found. Great is the LORD'S anger that burns against us because those who have gone before us have not obeyed the words of this book; they have not acted in accordance with all that is written there concerning us." 2 Kings 22:12–13
