### DAILY MEDITATIONS

#### MONDAY

Read John 20:1-9. What do you think was Mary's emotional state when she went to the tomb? In verse 8 it says "the other disciple" believed – yet in verse 9 it says they still did not understand that Jesus had to rise from the dead. What kind of "belief" do you think he had at this stage? There were clearly stages of belief for these first disciples, just as there are today for those intrigued with Jesus. What does this tell you about how to respond to those who are in the same place the disciples were? How can you show patience and grace? Ask God to bring you closer to the risen Christ this week!

#### **TUESDAY**

Read John 20:10-23. Why do you suppose Mary is so moved by Jesus' single word: "Mary"? Have you ever "locked your door" and withdrawn from life because of fear and grief? Where do you need Jesus' "peace" right now: In some relationship? Work? Anxieties? Close your eyes and hear him say "Peace be with you". Thank Him for the peace the resurrection brings.

#### WEDNESDAY

Read Acts 2:42-47. This is a picture of what the early church was like—the resurrection of Jesus turned them from cowardly, hiding, backbiting disciples into this generous, joyful community. How does the certainty of a resurrection make you more joyful and generous in this life? What can you do to live more generously and joyously? Please pray that as we "sell our possessions and give to the poor" during the World's Biggest Garage Sale, God will be glorified!

#### **THURSDAY**

Read Acts 4:1-20. The people condemning Peter in these verses were the very same who conspired to have Jesus crucified. How would the resurrection of Jesus give Peter such boldness? What inspires you about Peter's example? Pray that you can be as confident as Peter!

#### **FRIDAY**

Read 1 Cor. 15:3-10. What about Christ is of "first importance"? Why is his death, burial, and resurrection the most important thing to believe about Jesus? How does the resurrection change the way you view life and death? How does it change the way you view Jesus? Ask God to help you live in light of the resurrection daily!

#### **SATURDAY**

To prepare for this weekend's message, please read Galatians 5:13-15 and 25-26. How does an understanding of grace change the way you react in relationships with others? Please pray for the weekend services. Thanks!
