

1. A new perspective on ______ (Acts 16:6-10)

Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, **having been kept by the Holy Spirit** from preaching the word in the province of Asia. When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but **the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them to**... During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." After Paul had seen the vision, we got ready at once to leave for Macedonia, concluding that **God had called us to preach the gospel to them**. Acts 16:6-7,9-10

3. A new perspective on ______ (Acts 16:16-40)

The crowd joined in the attack against Paul and Silas, and the magistrates ordered them to be stripped and beaten with rods. After they had been severely flogged, they were thrown into prison, and the jailer was commanded to guard them carefully. When he received these orders, he put them in the inner cell and fastened their feet in the stocks. **About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God**, and the other prisoners were listening to them. Acts 16:22-25 (See Philippians 4)
