DAILY DEVOTIONS

MONDAY

Read Matt. 5:14-16. Jesus wants our church to be a “city on a hill” and let our light shine. What are some ways you can “let your light shine” – perhaps through opportunities offered through TLC? Ask God to help you let your light shine!

TUESDAY

Read John 17:18. How is God sending you? To whom can you, even in subtle ways, be an “ambassador” of the kingdom of God, through your actions and attitudes? Ask God to help you be prepared to give a reason for the hope that you have.

WEDNESDAY

Read 1 Peter 3:15-16. How prepared are you to share your faith? In your mind, describe how you would share your faith story in 3 or 4 minutes. Ask God to help you share... with gentleness and respect.

THURSDAY

Read 2 Corinthians 8:2-3. Paul talks about the Macedonian Christians giving, not out of obligation, but out of spontaneous generosity and overflowing joy! How can really understanding God's love lead to this attitude? Ask God to help you give and reach out from gracious motives, not out of a sense of guilt.

FRIDAY

Read Jeremiah 29:4-7. How can we seek the peace and prosperity of Santa Cruz County? How often do you pray for your city? Do you love it? Are you serving your community in some way that leads to its prosperity and peace? Ask God to help you seek the peace and prosperity of your “city” – and that your efforts would draw people to the gospel.

SATURDAY

In preparation for this weekend's message, read Joshua 1:7-9 and ask God how this applies to your life right now! Please pray for us this weekend as we launch a brand new series in Joshua! Thanks!
